
Instructional Video





Supplies

- Hot coco
- Bone folder
- Scrapbook paper
- Hot glue and tacky glue
- Die cut snowflakes or other embellishments
- Scissors
- Templates : Mini carrier Lori Whitlock [click here](#).
- Mini coffee cup sleeve Etsy store [click here](#).




Cut card stock for coco pouches to 6 x 6" . Take one end and fold it into a triangular shape. Then take the two bottom edges and fold to the middle. Fold the front flap down and glue into place.

Accordion fold the rosette and glue together. Cut a piece of patterned paper or cardstock to 1 ½" x 12" and create the belly band.

Put the carrier together with glue. Use clothes pins if necessary to hold things together while the glue is drying.

Attach the sleeve pieces to the mini cup using tacky glue or hot glue. Make a decorative top for it by using a 2" circle punch and embellish as desired. In the video I used a snowflake.
